SOPS FOR KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA BAR COUNCIL ELECTION-2025.

- 1. There shall be no break/interval for lunch during the polling time.
- 2. No candidate or supports are allowed to distribute lunch boxes or arrange lunch in any other form within the precincts and also outside the premises of the polling stations.
- 3. The polling time shall be from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM without any break. At the end of time, only those voters who are inside the premises of polling stations shall be allowed to cast vote. Decision of Presiding officer in this respect shall be binding.
- 4. Refreshment, tea, high tea shall not be allowed.
- 5. Campaign or canvassing for vote is strictly prohibited within the premises of polling stations.
- 6. Use of cameras, mobiles phones etc shall be strictly prohibited inside the polling station. Secrecy of the ballot shall be maintained.
- The voter will be allowed to enter the premises of the polling station only after production of valid original CNIC and original Bar Council Card.
- CCPO/Chief Traffic Officer & DPOs shall ensure the law and order situation on election day, i.e. 01-11-2025. Police personnel shall be deployed within and outside the precincts of the polling stations sufficiently, at the direction of Presiding Officer.
- There shall be control rooms for Returning Officer in Advocate General Office & KP Bar Council.
- 10. Chief Justice Peshawar High, Court will be requested for closing the principal seat and working of branches of the High court on 01st November, 2025.
- 11. There shall be no gathering of supporters in any case outside the Polling booths.
- 12. Appropriate space shall be reserved for pooling booths. Presiding officer may at their discretion fix number of polling booths and request the Additional District and Session Judges / Civil Judges at the station to act as polling officer.

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- 13. The Presiding officers shall send the result to specific WhatsApp number of Returning Officer immediately after counting the Votes, and also send the election material in sealed form to the Returning officer.
- 14. As per the direction of Election Tribunal (High Court), result shall be in no case be compiled and announced before close of polling time.

SOPs REGARDING BALLOT PAPERS

- 1. Polling agents will be allowed to enter in the premises of polling station only upon production of written authentication by the candidate. Table/seats for the polling agents shall be at a distance of at least 8 feet from polling staff and polling booths.
- 2. Polling agents shall not be allowed to canvass inside the polling stations, nor walk around the polling booths.
- 3. All the candidates shall inform the Returning Officer in writing with regard to polling stations where they desire to cast their vote.
- 4. Henceforth, panaflexes/banners/rounds are strictly prohibited for all candidates.
- 5. No one will be allowed to arrange any lunch/dinner in office and no encroachment in the name of election office will be allowed.
- 6. Before issuing the ballot paper, the polling officer must ascertain that it bears the seal and signature of the Returning Officer and that he, shall also, affix his seal and signature on the reverse/back side of the ballot paper at the time casting of vote. Each ballot paper shall be counter signed and stamped by the presiding /polling officer at its back.
- 7. Wherever, the signature and seal was not affixed by the polling officer on the reverse side of the ballot paper, the same shall be considered as bogus and invalid vote.
- 8. The result prepared by the polling officer shall be furnished to the Returning officer through WhatsApp/FAX after signing.
- 9. The original result in hard copy and other material of the election process shall be delivered immediately to the Returning Officer in sealed packet.
- 10. The card/other material regarding canvassing shall be prohibited in area of polling station.
- 11. No outsider shall be allowed in the area of polling station, in case of any violation in this respect, action shall be taken against the delinquent in accordance with law. 778-10.25

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONDUCTING OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA

ELECTION 2025.

Dear Sir / Madam,

For the convenience of Presiding / Polling Officers, General Instruction regarding election of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Election 2025 are given as under:-

RULE 13

(1) The Returning Officer shall publish, at least 30 days before the polling, a list of voters showing at which polling station particular voter shall cast their vote: Provide that the Returning Officer shall have the power to add to the least till the polling is held:

Provided further that no person shall be entitled to vote if he ceases to be an advocate before the poll.

(2) All voters shall cast their votes at the polling stations indicated in the list except voters appointed as polling agents who shall be entitled to cast their votes at the polling stations for which they have been appointed as polling agents. A candidate may cast his vote at any polling station.

RULE 16

The Returning Officer shall provide the polling officer with a list of voters of the area for which he/she has been appointed the polling officer.

RULE 17

- (1) The [Presiding Officer] shall conduct the poll in accordance with the provisions of these Rules and shall exercise all necessary powers for maintaining order at the polling station and shall report to the Returning Officer any fact or incident which in his opinion affect the conduct or fairness of the poll.
- (2) It shall be the duty of a Presiding Officer to do all such acts and things as may be necessary for affectively conducting the polls in accordance with the provisions of these Rules.

RULE 18

- (i) The Ballot Box shall be such as may be provided by the Returning Officer.
- (ii) The [Presiding Officer] shall ensure before the commencement of the poll that each box is empty and is properly sealed in the balloting position and is placed before him prior to the receiving of the ballot papers.

RULE 19

The [Presiding Officer] shall, subject to such instructions as the Returning Officer may give, regulate the entry of persons to be polling station and exclude therefrom all persons except:

- (a) Any person on duty in connection with the election.
- (b) Contesting candidates and one polling agent of each contesting candidate.
- (c) No canvassing shall be allowed inside the polling station.

RULE 20

- There shall be displayed outside the place of the poll a list of the contesting candidates;
- (ii) To enable the voters to mark their ballot papers in secret the [Presiding Officer] shall set up polling both screened from observation where voters shall record their votes:
- (iii) The Returning Officer shall provide sufficient number of ballot boxes, copies of the list of voters, ballot papers, stamps for making official mark, writing material for indicating preferences on the ballot papers and such other articles as may be necessary for facilitating the casting of votes.

RULE 21

In Election of:-

 (i) A Provincial Bar Council each voter shall have as many votes as the number of members to be elected from the group of Districts to that Bar Council; &

RULE 22

- (1) The ballot paper for the election to a member of Provincial Bar Council shall be issued to the voter by the [Presiding Officer] only against the production of an identity card issued by him such Provincial Bar Council. The Returning Officer by a general order may also direct production of CNIC of the voter in addition to Identity card issued to him/ her by the Bar Council or the Bar Associations concerned.
- (2) A voter, on receiving the ballot paper, shall forthwith;-
 - a) Proceed to the polling booth;
 - Record his/ her vote on the ballot paper by putting a cross [(x) or tick (✓)]
 against the name of the candidate for whom the voter intends to vote;
 - c) Fold the ballot paper so as to conceal his vote;
 - (cc) Each ballot paper shall be countersigned and stamped by the Presiding / Polling Officer at its back; and
 - (d) Insert the ballot paper into the ballot box.
- (3) No voter shall be allowed to enter the voting booth when another voter is inside it.

RULE 23

Voting shall take place generally under the directions, control and supervision of the Returning Officer at such hours as the Returning Officer may direct on the date or dates already fixed for voting in the programme, but the Returning Officer may for sufficient reasons direct that the voting may continue after the date or dates fixed. Directions given by the Returning Officer shall be put on the notice board of his office and a copy thereof shall be sent to the Presidents of all the Bar Associations for being pasted at the notice boards of the Bar Associations.

RULE 24

- (1) Voting shall be by secret ballot.
- (2) A voter who has inadvertently spoiled his ballot paper so that it cannot be used may, after satisfying the [Presiding Officer] about the fact of inadvertence, return the ballot paper to the Presiding Officer who shall issue another ballot paper after cancelling the spoiled the ballot paper which shall be placed in a packet labeled "spoiled ballot papers" noting the fact of cancellation on the counter file also.
- (3) If any ballot paper which has been issued to a voter has not been inserted by him into the ballot box, but is found to be anywhere else it shall be cancelled and counted for as "spoiled ballot paper".

RULE 25

(1) At the close of the polling, the Presiding Officer shall count in the presence of the candidates or their agents the votes cast for the various candidates and shall for what the ballot papers and the result of counting in a sealed cover to the Returning Officer.

The Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar in its judgment dated: 13-3-2017 in Bar Council election objection petition No: 10-P/2015 has observed the following.

"The Khyber PakhtunKhwa Bar Council is directed that in future the Presiding officer of any polling station shall not announce/ declare the result of the election prior to closing hours/time of the polling."

Therefore, all the respectable Presiding / Polling Officer are requested to conduct free and fair election as per above mention instructions / rules.

Note: All the election materials shall taken by the Presiding / Polling Officers in sealed condition and shall be returned to this office in sealed form and safe custody.
